As an early-career researcher with 10 years of ISCA engagement, prosody has been central to my work ever since I started working on speech boundaries and their interface with syntax and gesture during my PhD, in production and perception. After publishing in this area, I began collaborating with clinicians on speech pauses in breast cancer survivors, which deepened my commitment to fostering dialogue across SProSIG's diverse methodologies and populations. I was delighted to see a wide spectrum of research interests, populations, and methods showcased at Speech Prosody 2026, and I would like to encourage even more dialogue and exchange across subfields. I have served as secretary of a scientific association for two years, organizing elections and managing member communications, and co-organized two international conferences (~100 participants) managing submissions and reviewing, registration, and logistics. With this experience and community engagement, I want to strengthen SProSIG's institutional foundation and encourage cross-disciplinary exchange.
